

Biosketch Vishal Madaan, MD, FAPA, DFAACAP AADPRT Position: Co-chair, Psychotherapy Committee

Vishal Madaan, MD, is Associate Professor in Psychiatry and Child Psychiatry at University of Virginia, Charlottesville. He is the founding Director for the Center for Psychopharmacology Research in Youth at UVA and serves as Associate Training Director for the child and adolescent



psychiatry fellowship program there. In the recent past, Dr. Madaan served as the Medical Director of the UVA child and family clinic, and Associate training director of the general psychiatry program at University of Virginia as well as Creighton University.

Dr. Madaan has co-authored several articles and book chapters for peer-reviewed scientific and medical journals. He has presented his research and chaired sessions at both national and international psychiatry meetings. He has been the chief editor for the child psychiatry section of the ASCP Model Psychopharmacology Curriculum for more than a decade. He currently serves as Associate Editor for the Child PRITE and on the editorial board of the PRITE as well as APA Focus self-assessment. Dr. Madaan was specialty chief editor for the journal Frontiers in Child and Neurodevelopmental Psychiatry and his areas of clinic interest include ADHD and pediatric mood disorders. He is also a member of the UVA Academy of Distinguished Educators.

Dr. Madaan is very passionate about understanding training issues related to International Medical Graduates and Diversity. As a recipient of the IMG fellowship, George Ginsberg award and Peter Henderson award, he has been with AADPRT since his formative years. He has served as the Chair of the AADPRT Rao/Lu IMG fellowship for more than two terms during which he mentored several IMG residents. He has served on AADPRT nominating committee and currently chairs the IMG caucus.
