Abstracts must be submitted via this system. Read ALL instructions before beginning your submission *as significant changes have occurred for 2022.*

- Submitting member of an accepted abstract will be point of contact for all workshop or poster-related details.
- American Psychiatric Association will collect disclosure forms in 12/2022 via unique email link sent to each presenter. Completion is required.
- Presenters may be included in a maximum of three workshops.
- Maximum number of presenters for a workshop or poster is five. No exceptions.
- Submissions should not include special requests.
- All workshop and poster presenters must register and pay for the meeting.
- Specify in the abstract if your workshop or poster has been produced by trainees with a faculty mentor/AADPRT member.
- Once submitted, changes are not allowed to abstract or participants.
- Scheduling requests will not be accepted.
- Any slides must be uploaded [here](#) no later than Thursday, February 16, 2023. This is an accreditation requirement.
- Abstracts that reflect Annual Meeting theme and/or include first-time presenters and multiple programs will be given priority.
