Boarded in both Psychiatry and Neurology (ABPN) and Behavioral Neurology/Neuropsychiatry (UCNS), he is Past President of the American Neuropsychiatric Association (ANPA) and the American Association of Directors of Psychiatry Residency Training (AADPRT) and currently serves as a Psychiatry Director of the American Board of Psychiatry and Neurology (ABPN). He has won numerous teaching awards including the University of Massachusetts' Chancellor's Medal for Distinguished Teaching as well as ANPA's Gary J. Tucker Lifetime Achievement Award in Neuropsychiatry. He lectures and publishes widely in the field of Neuropsychiatry.
