Submission Deadline 09/14/2023

Abstracts for posters and workshops must be submitted via the member portal by paid AADPRT members (AADPRT does not extend membership to trainees).

Before logging in to begin your submission, please read ALL instructions ***as changes have occurred for 2023 submission.***

- Submitting member of an accepted abstract will be point of contact for all workshop or poster-related details.
- American Psychiatric Association will collect disclosure forms December, 2023 via an email with a unique link for each presenter. Completion is required for participation.
- Presenters may be included in a maximum of three workshops.
- Maximum number of presenters/authors for a workshop or poster is five. No exceptions.
- Submissions should not include special requests.
- The body of the abstract should not reference program or institution so as to allow for blinded review by abstract review committee.
- All workshop and poster presenters must register and pay for the meeting.
- Specify in the abstract if your workshop or poster has been produced by trainees with a faculty mentor/AADPRT member.
- Once submitted, changes are not allowed to abstract or participants.
- Scheduling requests will not be accepted.
- Any slides must be uploaded [here](#) no later than February 15, 2024. This is an accreditation requirement.
- Abstracts that reflect Annual Meeting theme and/or include first-time presenters and multiple programs will be given priority.
