You also rotate through the 125th Street Clinic of the Manhattan Psychiatric Center, the Kirby Forensic Psychiatric Center, the Rockland Psychiatric Center, and the Student Counseling and Wellness Services at NYU Washington Square. During these rotations, you are supervised by our faculty, which includes world-class basic scientists, clinical researchers, and clinician-educators. Along with gaining the clinical and academic experiences required by the Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education (ACGME), our residents contribute to a wide variety of research projects, assisted by mentors. We strongly encourage you to participate in scholarly activities during training and advocate for your ability to pursue your research interests and apply for fellowships or grants when appropriate. All residents on psychiatry rotations can use Thursdays to dedicate to didactics and scholarship/research opportunities.
