

## Call for Nominations: Abstract Review Committee

Please consider nominating yourself or others to the Abstract Review Committee for the 2024 AADPRT Annual Meeting. We want a committee that represents the diversity of AADPRT and ensures that the selected workshops and posters do the same. Each committee member will serve on either the workshop or poster sub-committee. Committee members will review and rate abstracts with a provided rubric on their own and then meet as a subcommittee to make decisions. Review takes place September 15 – October 19. ## FAQs

- **Can I be on the committee this year if I was on the committee last year?**

Yes, some past members will be selected again, however, to add new voices to the committee, we ask that persons do not nominate someone who served the past three years.
- **Can I serve on the committee if I am planning to submit an abstract?**

Yes, however, committee members are expected to recuse themselves from reviewing or discussing any abstracts where they might have a conflict of interest.
- **When are committee nominations due?**
  - August 17, 5pm ET
- **When will the abstract review committee be announced?**
  - September 1
- **How many submissions will there be?**

We are uncertain, but below is data from past years.

  - 2021 Annual Meeting: 37 posters, 72 workshops.
  - 2022 Annual Meeting: 53 posters, 79 workshops.
  - 2023 Annual Meeting: 52 posters, 78 workshops
- **How many people are on the committee?**
  - We hope to have 8 to 12 people divided between the two Sub-Committees.
- **What is the review timeline?**
  - September 15 – October 19
  - October 20 – Rank order list of posters and workshops is due
