Our four-year residency program offers an outstanding academic medical education within a variety of inpatient and outpatient settings. The 400 bed medical center is the tertiary referral hospital for 598,575 Kaiser Permanente members. Our patient population reflects Southern California demographic and ethnic diversity – 39 percent Caucasian, 29 percent Latino, 15 percent African-American, and 14 percent Asian.
