Hello, and thank you for your interest in our program! The fully accredited psychiatry residency program combines university and community resources to train psychiatric physicians. CAMC is accredited by the Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education (ACGME) as a sponsoring institution of graduate medical education residency and fellowship programs. The CAMC Behavioral Medicine and Psychiatry Residency is sponsored by CAMC. West Virginia University Charleston Campus is an affiliate educational partner.

This arrangement offers a diverse patient population and the opportunity to train in a tertiary center, which also functions as a community hospital. We offer training in general psychiatry (4 years) and combined internal medicine/psychiatry (5 years). Our residents serve patients from a wide geographical range and play an integral part in improving access to care for West Virginians.

Our residents receive a wealth of diverse training in inpatient settings such as our inpatient psychiatric unit and a robust consultation liaison service. With four child and adolescent psychiatrists on faculty, our residents also receive quality training in that area. Our residents have the privilege of learning from Charleston's only geriatric psychiatrist, and they get to participate in an impactful Comprehensive Opioid Addiction Treatment (COAT) program ran by our board-certified addiction psychiatrist. With two faculty members board-certified in forensic psychiatry, our residents also receive comprehensive education in medico-legal topics. As a result, our residents often pursue fellowship opportunities after their residency training. Our recent graduates have attained fellowship positions in high quality programs in their desired field.

In addition to psychiatry faculty, our residents are able to learn from top tier psychologists whose specialties range from eating disorders, child therapy, transgender mental health, dialectical behavioral therapy, and more.
