The program aims to:

- Recruit well-prepared physicians who are passionate about patient care, who work well in a team and communicate well, and who contribute to the community through service, scholarship, science, or social responsibility.
- Provide residents with comprehensive training in psychiatry, including longitudinal outpatient experiences, incorporating psychotherapy and psychopharmacology, allowing for tailoring of the training experience, emphasizing quality improvement and patient safety, and ensuring mentorship and faculty support.
- Foster a diverse, inclusive, and healthy environment that provides for regular comprehensive feedback and support, and allows for a balance of clinical, educational, and personal/ professional responsibilities, while also allowing for each resident to have an active role in their own professional development.
- Prepare residents to become effective leaders in a variety of settings including clinical care, advocacy, public health (including community mental health and rural psychiatry), and scholarship (including education and research).
