She has served as Chair of the AADPRT Assessment Committee (2021-2025), Chair of the AADPRT CBME Implementation Task Force (2025- 2026), Chair of the AADPRT CAP EPA Sub-Task Force (2025-present) and Chair of the Henderson Award Committee (2024-2026). She has presented over 15 workshops at AADPRT on topics ranging from ethics and professionalism to recruitment, CSVs, CBME and equity in assessment. Currently, she is on the AACAP Crisis in Recruitment Task Force which has been working on novel training pathways to address the shortage of child and adolescent psychiatrists.
