

Call for Abstract Review Committee

Please consider nominating yourself or others to the Abstract Review Committee for the 2023 AADPRT Annual Meeting. We want a committee that represents the diversity of AADPRT and ensures that the selected workshops and posters do the same. Each committee member will serve on either the workshop or poster sub-committee. Committee members will review and rate abstracts with a provided rubric on their own and then meet as a subcommittee to make decisions. In order to provide adequate time for the Abstract Review Committees to complete their work, we have moved up the deadline for workshop and poster submissions this year. The review process will take place over 4 weeks (an increase from 2 weeks last year) from September 21 – October 20. Diversity will be a priority for committee membership. This is a great way to get more involved in AADPRT and add a national committee to your CV. **Selfnominations are encouraged! Link to submit is below.**

FAQ

• Can I be on the committee this year if I was on the committee last year?

Yes, we will be piloting having some experienced members on the committee. We anticipate no longer than 3 years of service on the Abstract Review Committee to allow for appropriate turn over and member opportunities.

- When are committee nominations due?
 - August 31, 5pm ET
- When will the abstract review committee be announced?
 - September 12
- How many submissions will there be?
 - For the 2020 Annual Meeting, there were 83 poster and 126 workshop submissions.

For the 2021 Annual Meeting, there were 37 poster and 72 workshop submissions.

- For the 2022 Annual Meeting, there were 53 poster and 79 workshop submissions.
- How many people are on the Committee?
 - We hope to have 8 to 12 people total divided between the two Sub-Committees.
- What is the timeline?
 - September 21 Start review, though selected committee members can begin reviewing September 13.
 - October 18 Rank order list of workshops is due
 - October 20 Rank order list of posters is due
