



Poster Requirements:

- Posters will be presented 3/2, 5:00 – 6:30pm and 3/3, 10:30 – 11 am.
- **For 2023, AADPRT prints and installs all posters – no exceptions; no cost to you.**
 - Poster artwork must be no larger than 72" W x 32" H (72" x 32" is print size).
 - You must upload a hi-res PDF (at least 300dpi, max file size 25MB) to [this form](#).
 - Indicate on the form:
 - Permission to upload your poster to our Virtual Training Office (VTO) (member-only access) after the meeting.
 - Desire to enter poster contest.
- **ABSOLUTE FILE SUBMISSION DEADLINE: JANUARY 19 (late posters cannot be presented at the Annual Meeting)**
- **All presenters** participating in your poster presentation are **required to register** and pay the appropriate fee for the meeting. Registration open through 2/9; rates increase 1/13.
- Changes to abstract or presenters **are not permitted** due to accreditation.
- **Handouts** (optional) must be posted online (cloud service of your choosing) and linked to a QR code you incorporate into your poster design. Create a free QR code [here](#). **Printed handouts not permitted at the meeting.**

Poster Preparation Tips:

- Lettering should be at least 3/8" in height, in bold, clean type. Fonts should be at least 14 points.
- Block coloring adds emphasis and clarity. Captions should be brief and labels few but clear. Avoid unnecessary details. Indicate (by numbers, letters, or arrows) a sequence for studying your material.
- Your poster should be self-explanatory so you can discuss points with poster viewers.
