She is an Associate Professor in Clinical Psychiatry at Perelman School of Medicine, University of Pennsylvania and Division Chief of Community Care and Wellness in the Department of Child and Adolescent Psychiatry and Behavioral Sciences at Children's Hospital of Philadelphia (CHOP.)

She is currently a Senior Associate Program Director and Advisor for the CHOP Fellowship Program, Philadelphia.
