She has presented widely on aspects of psychiatric education and career development, gender issues, and ethics and cultural aspects of psychiatry. Throughout her career she has combined work in acute inpatient psychiatry with the practice of long-term psychodynamic psychotherapy, finding each setting a rich resource for teaching and supervising about relationships, development, psychopathology, systems issues and psychiatric treatments, both pharmacologic and psychological. She teaches a number of courses in the psychotherapy sequence within the residency at The University of Chicago, and has presented at AADPRT on career development and on the disciplinary process.
