



## Call for Nominations: Abstract Review Committee

Please consider nominating yourself or others for the Abstract Review Committee for the 2027 AADPRT Annual Meeting. We want a committee that represents the diversity of AADPRT and ensures selected programming does the same. Each committee member will serve on the Workshop, Poster, or Innovations Showcase Subcommittee. Committee members will review and rate abstracts on their own with a provided rubric and then meet as a subcommittee to make decisions. This is a great way to get more involved in AADPRT with a limited time commitment as well as add a national committee to your CV. **Self-nominations are encouraged!**

### FAQs

- **Can I be on the committee this year if I was on the committee last year?**  
Yes, some past members will be selected again, however, to add new voices to the committee, we ask that persons do not nominate someone who served the past three consecutive years.
- **Can I serve on the committee if I am planning to submit an abstract?**  
Yes, however, committee members are expected to recuse themselves from reviewing or discussing any abstracts where they might have a conflict of interest.
- **What is the nomination deadline?**  
August 25, 5pm ET
- **When will the abstract review committee be announced?**  
August 31
- **How many submissions will there be?**  
It varies, but below is data from past Annual Meetings.
  - 2022: 53 posters, 79 workshops
  - 2023: 52 posters, 78 workshops
  - 2024: 50 posters, 98 workshops
  - 2025: 52 posters, 139 workshops
  - 2026: 35 posters, 79 workshops, 29 Innovations Showcase presentations
- **How many people are on the committee?**  
There are up to 36 – 12 review posters, 12 review workshops, and up to 12 will review Innovations Showcase presentations
- **What is the review timeline?**  
September 24 – October 22
