Dustin DeMoss, DO, is an Associate Professor at the University of North Texas Health Science Center and Texas Christian University School of Medicine in Fort Worth, Texas. Dr. DeMoss serves as the program director and vice chair of education for the Department of Psychiatry at John Peter Smith (JPS) Hospital in Fort Worth. Dr. DeMoss completed his undergraduate medical education and Master of Medical Science at the Texas College of Osteopathic Medicine, then matriculated into Tulane's combined Internal Medicine and Psychiatry residency in New Orleans, Louisiana. After serving as chief resident, he graduated from his residency program and moved back to Fort Worth to rejoin the University of North Texas Health Science Center and John Peter Smith Hospital to begin work on research, education, and quality patient care. Clinically, Dr. DeMoss supervises residents and fellows on the consult/liaison and inpatient services and helped to launch JPS' addiction medicine service. Through this addition of a service line and his role as its inaugural medical director, he obtained his addiction medicine board certification. He has been a member of AADPRT since 2015, and in addition to serving on AADPRT's addiction committee, Dr. DeMoss is active on AADPRT's Workforce and Development committees.
