Dr. Ronke Babalola is the Child and Adolescent Psychiatry
Fellowship Director at Tower Health-Phoenixville Hospital and
Pediatric Consultation-Liaison Psychiatrist at St. Christopher's
Hospital for Children in Philadelphia. She holds faculty positions
as an Assistant Professor of Psychiatry at Drexel University
College of Medicine and Adjunct Assistant Professor at Rutgers Robert Wood
Johnson Medical School.

Previously, Dr. Babalola directed pediatric consultation liaison services at Bristol-Myers Squibb Children's Hospital and served as Medical Director of Emergency Psychiatry at Hackensack Meridian Hospital in New Jersey. She completed her fellowship at Harvard Medical School/Boston Children's Hospital, where she was Chief Liaison Fellow, after serving as Chief Resident at Nassau University Medical Center/Hofstra University School of Medicine.

Dr. Babalola has made significant contributions through book chapters, publications, and presentations on various topics, including ADHD, eating disorders, anxiety, LGBTQIA health, adolescent suicide, and autism spectrum disorders. Her dedication to medical education has earned her an Outstanding Teacher Award. She is actively involved with national and international organizations, such as the American Academy of Child and Adolescent Psychiatry Autism/Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities Working Group and has directed medical student rotations in child and adolescent consultation liaison psychiatry.
