 - Relevant leadership experience outside of AADPRT
 - Short and long-term career goals

At least three members of the NC will conduct the interview via Zoom (members listed below). You will be asked the following questions:

1. What is your vision for AADPRT? What would your principal priorities and goals be?
2. Why do you want to be the Program Chair elect and in AADPRT leadership?
3. Describe your contributions to AADPRT and their impact.
4. Of all of your leadership experiences in or out of AADPRT, what are you most proud of and why?
5. How are you going to manage the workload with your current day position?
6. How will you advance equity?

Interviews will be recorded so all NC members can review them.

NC will use a rubric in evaluating each nominee that includes the following factors:

1. Vision
2. Motivation
3. AADPRT contributions and service
4. Leadership
5. Bandwidth
6. Potential to advance equity
