Dr. Ronke Babalola is the Associate Division Chief of Child and Adolescent Psychiatry at Hackensack University Medical Center where she is also a Pediatric Consultation Liaison Psychiatrist. She holds a faculty position as Assistant Professor of Behavioral Health at Hackensack Meridian School of Medicine. She is an adjunct Assistant Professor of Psychiatry at Drexel University College of Medicine and Assistant Professor at Rutgers Robert Wood Johnson Medical School.

Previously, Dr. Babalola directed pediatric consultation liaison services at St. Christopher Hospital and Bristol-Myers Squibb Children's Hospital and served as Medical Director of Emergency Psychiatry at Hackensack Meridian Hospital. She completed her fellowship at Harvard Medical School/Boston Children's Hospital as Chief Liaison Fellow, after serving as Chief Resident at Nassau University Medical Center/Hofstra University School of Medicine.

Dr. Babalola has contributed to literature on ADHD, eating disorders, anxiety, LGBTQIA health, adolescent suicide, and autism spectrum disorders. Her dedication to teaching earned her an Outstanding Teacher Award. She serves on the JEDI Committee at AADPRT, currently chairs the Curriculum Committee, previously served on the Nomination Committee, and is active with the American Academy of Child and Adolescent Psychiatry Autism/Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities Working Group.
