Dr. Daniel Gih is a Professor and Vice Chair of Education in the Department of Psychiatry at the University of Nebraska Medical Center. He is the founding program director of the UNMC Psychiatry Residency Program, which reopened in 2020 after a three-decade hiatus.



Dr. Gih provides clinical care at the Child and Adolescent Outpatient Psychiatry Clinic. He earned his medical degree from the University of Iowa and completed his psychiatry residency and child and adolescent psychiatry fellowship at the University of Michigan. While on the faculty at Michigan, he co-founded and directed the University of Michigan Comprehensive Eating Disorder Program, the state's only academic partial hospitalization program for children and young adults with eating disorders.

His interests include professional development, undergraduate and graduate medical education, severe mood disorders in adolescents, and eating disorders. He is active in national psychiatric organizations and is a Distinguished Fellow of both the American Psychiatric Association and the American Academy of Child & Adolescent Psychiatry.
