



Abstract Submission Instructions

Abstracts for Arts in Action Presentations, Innovations Showcase Presentations, Posters, and Workshops must be submitted via the member portal by AADPRT members whose dues are current (AADPRT does not extend membership to trainees). **Please read ALL instructions below before beginning your submission as changes have occurred for 2026.**

- Presenters may be included in a **maximum of three (3)** workshops and must remove themselves from any accepted abstracts above the maximum of three (3). No exceptions.
- **Maximum of five (5) presenters** per abstract. No exceptions.
- Submissions should not include special requests, including scheduling. There are too many submissions for special requests to be considered.
- Abstracts that reflect Annual Meeting theme and/or include first-time presenters and multiple programs will be given priority.
- **All abstract presenters must register and pay for the meeting if they plan to participate.**
- Specify in the abstract if content has been produced by trainees with a faculty mentor/AADPRT member.
- Once submitted, changes are not allowed to abstracts or participants.
- The submitter of an accepted abstract will be the point of contact for all abstract-related details.
- The American Psychiatric Association (APA) will collect disclosure forms in December, 2026 via a unique email link sent to each presenter. **Completion is required.**
- Any slides must be received no later than Thursday, February 5, 2027. This is an accreditation requirement.
