The Emory Residency Program provides excellent clinical training as well as opportunities to develop as an educator and researcher. Emory offers one of the most diverse clinical training sites in the country. Residents have inpatient rotations in a variety of settings including Emory University Hospital, Grady Memorial Hospital and the Atlanta VA Medical Center. Residents begin outpatient psychotherapy training in their second year and have supervision in group, cognitive behavioral and psychodynamic psychotherapy. This experience is complemented by a psychopharmacology clinics. Within the psychiatry residency program, we have three specialty tracks: global and population health, psychotherapy, and research. In 2007, a five-year joint degree program in internal medicine and psychiatry was initiated, further increasing the diversity of training possibilities for our residents.
