We are a medium size program situated in the heart of downtown Chicago. There are 9 residents per class including one resident in an R25-funded research track. We look to recruit residents interested in practicing in a busy, urban environment. Our mission is to train future leaders in the field of psychiatry and foster specialization by the fourth year of training. Our residents train at Northwestern Memorial Hospital, the Jesse Brown VA, and Lurie Childrens' Hospital and multiple other sites are available to explore electives. We have robust services in consultation-liaison psychiatry, neuropsychiatry, women's mental health, child-adolescent psychiatry, and forensics. We have a full day of protected time dedicated to didactics, grand rounds, case conferences, and administrative work. Residents pursue scholarly projects and have protected time in the fourth year for this work. We encourage residents to attend national meetings to present their work, and funds are available for residents to present. We continue to strike a great balance in educating residents about neuroscience and biological psychiatry and learning multiple psychotherapy modalities.
