The Department of Psychiatry and Behavioral Medicine is part of the Brody School of Medicine at East Carolina University. East Carolina University is a large and modern institution of higher learning located in Greenville, North Carolina. The Brody School of Medicine has as its primary teaching site Vidant Medical Center, a state-of-the-art tertiary medical care facility and a part of the Vidant Health System of Eastern Carolina.

Our residency program provides opportunities to train in a variety of training sites throughout eastern North Carolina. The patient population is socially, economically and racially diverse and is drawn from Pitt County and the surrounding 33 counties. Residents have opportunities to develop specialized skills for the practice of rural psychiatry and are exposed to telemedicine as one way of expanding a service delivery system.
