Dr. Omair Abbasi is the Program Director of the Psychiatry Residency at Memorial Healthcare System in Hollywood, Florida, where he previously served as Associate Program Director and continues to practice as a CL psychiatrist. He is board certified in Psychiatry and Psychosomatic Medicine, with specialized expertise in neuropsychiatry and the integration of behavioral health within medical settings.



Dr. Abbasi has a longstanding commitment to psychiatric education, with prior leadership roles including Director of Behavioral Health Education and Psychiatry Clerkship Director at Nova Southeastern University, and Assistant Clerkship Director at Thomas Jefferson University. In addition, Dr. Abbasi leads the Florida Psychiatric Society's RIPPLE program (Residents in Psychiatry Programs: Leadership Experience), which trains chief residents across Florida in leadership skills, fostering leadership development in residency. His work focuses on curriculum development, faculty development, and advancing educational strategies that support learner growth across the continuum of medical education.

At the national level, Dr. Abbasi serves as Chair of the AADPRT Community Program Caucus and was recently appointed to the AADPRT Executive Council. He is also a member of the ACGME Psychiatry Requirements Revision Task Force, advocating for the unique needs of community-based training programs.
