In addition to working with a variety of patient populations at these sites, we offer a wide exposure to different treatment settings (inpatient hospital, outpatient clinic, day program, consultation-liaison, integrated mental health, and long-term psychotherapy), instruction in many different aspects of psychiatric treatment (psychodynamic therapies, cognitive behavioral therapies, group therapy, brief interventions, psychopharmacology, and neuromodulation including ECT and TMS), and an approach to the understanding of mental illness that incorporates neuroscience, evidence-based medicine, social determinants of health, structural competency, health equity, and psychodynamic approaches.
