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Call for Abstracts

We hope each member will seriously consider submitting an abstract for workshops and/or posters for the 2022 American Association of Directors of Psychiatry Residency Training (AADPRT) Annual Meeting at the Hilton Minneapolis (MN) March 8-12, 2022.

This year's meeting theme is **"Changing Self and Systems: Advancing Diversity, Equity, and Inclusivity in Residency Training"**. Presenting a workshop or poster is a great way to help all of us learn and grow as educators. Each submission is evaluated by the Abstract Review Committee with respect to relevance, content/rigor/evidence, and pedagogy/structure on a four-point scale and then overall. Priority will be given to first-time presenters and multi-institutional teams.

All abstract submissions must be made electronically through AADPRT's online abstract submission system by an AADPRT member (dues must be up to date). We allow abstract submissions for two categories: workshops and posters.

- **Workshops:** Workshops should be highly interactive sessions that enable participants to learn new skills and approaches. All workshops are 75 minutes long. Workshops may include short didactic input(s) but primarily utilize interactive techniques in small and large group formats. Reserve the last 15 minutes for questions and discussion, including 5 minutes for members to complete the evaluation form. Handouts are encouraged.
- **Posters:** Poster sessions allow authors to present and discuss original research and/or innovations with other meeting participants. Handouts are encouraged. Presenters are responsible for producing their own poster. If selected, a PDF file of posters must be submitted to the Program Committee by January 13, 2022 to also be considered for the annual poster competition.
