Her psychiatry residency training was completed at UT Southwestern Medical Center Dallas and she completed a fellowship in Geriatric Psychiatry from The University of Washington School of Medicine.

Dr. Garcia-Pittman is currently the outpatient clinic director at Ascension Medical Group (AMG) Seton Behavioral Health and is the rotation site director for the Adult and Geriatric Psychiatry outpatient training clinics. She serves as Program Director of the Geriatric Psychiatry Fellowship Program at UT Austin Dell Medical School. Dr. Garcia-Pittman spends much of her clinical time teaching and training psychiatry fellows, residents and medical students to care for older adults.
