

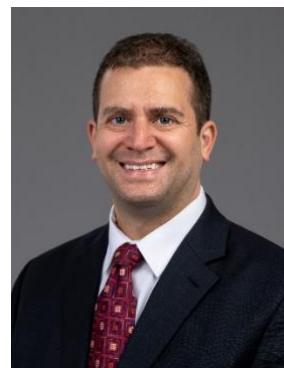

Dr. Eitan Kimchi is a geriatric psychiatrist at the University of Illinois College of Medicine-Chicago campus, where he serves as Director of Medical Student Education in Psychiatry, Director of Academic Initiatives in Psychiatry, and Co-Director of the Interdisciplinary Memory Clinic.

He completed his psychiatry residency at the University of Maryland/Sheppard Pratt Psychiatry Residency Program in 2013 and his geriatric psychiatry fellowship at Johns Hopkins University in 2014. He remained on faculty at Johns Hopkins before relocating to the Chicagoland area in 2016.

From 2016 to 2022, Dr. Kimchi served on faculty at Rush University Medical Center, where he held several leadership roles, including Associate Psychiatry Residency Training Director of Psychiatry, Medical Director of Emergency Psychiatry, and Associate Medical Director of the Section of Geriatric Psychiatry.

He joined the Department of Psychiatry at the University of Illinois College of Medicine-Chicago campus in 2022. In addition to his current leadership roles, he has served in multiple educational and administrative positions, including Psychiatry Residency Training Director, Associate Psychiatry Residency Training Director, and Director of Psychiatry Residency Program's Clinician Educator Track.

Dr. Kimchi's clinical and academic work focuses on dementia-related care, medical education, and emergency psychiatry. He has authored several textbook chapters and papers on geriatric psychiatry, cognitive disorders, behavioral disturbances in dementia, decision-making capacity, and emergency psychiatry. He is an active member of the Alzheimer's Association Illinois Advocacy Team.
